LIGHTS ON

FOR GOLDEN MILE

OFFICIALS FROM THE NEW SOUTH WALES HARNESS RACING CLUB HAVE INDICATED THAT THEY MAY RUN TWO \$20,000 TABCORP GOLDEN MILE DIVISIONS AT TABCORP PARK MENANGLE'S FIRST NIGHT MEETING ON FRIDAY WEEK.

The race program, which will be the first time that the new lights at the state-of-the-art facility will be turned on, is the first Friday night meeting to be held at Australasia's super track.

NSWHRC Chief Executive John Dumesny said if there were sufficient nominations for the Golden Mile, the main race on the card, that two divisions would be conducted on what is expected to be a nine race program.

The Golden Mile itself is favoured to run with two divisions as local pacers scramble to improve their rankings for the upcoming Watpac Inter Dominion.

With the Tabcorp Golden Mile meeting to be held on January 29, third rankings for the Inter Dominion are released two days earlier with the final rankings issued on Tuesday, February 9.

Many of New South Wales' best horses still in contention for a spot in the series are likely to be nominated for the Golden Mile in a chance to further enhance their claims for ID10.

The lighting system will be given a complete and thorough workout during trials to be held at Menangle on Monday, January 25 from 8pm.
