DOMINATE BIG6 HUNTER CUP

TOMORROW NIGHT'S BIG6 HUNTER CUP AT MOONEE VALLEY WILL BE THE LAST CHANCE FOR LEADING CONTENDERS TO ROUND OUT THEIR PREPARATIONS FOR THE WATPAC INTER DOMINION IN SYDNEY, COMMENCING ON FEBRUARY 19.

Of the Hunter Cup's 15 runners (including one emergency), 11 are nominated for Watpac ID10, including defending Inter champion, Mr Feelgood.

NSW-based Karloo Mick has drawn the pole in Saturday night's standing-start feature, and is sure to give his backers another great sight following his brave third to Cincinnati Kid in last week's Ballarat Cup.

The Barry Lew-trained nine-year-old has placed twice in Inter Dominion Grand Finals, once in 2006 and again last year.

Washakie, recent winner of the WA Pacing Cup and Treuer Memorial, is off 10 metres for former New South Welshman, John McCarthy and is considered a good each-way chance.

He has a sense of timing about him leading into the Inter Dominion and is currently rated a \$14 chance on TAB Fixed Odds to win the series.

Other runners engaged in the Hunter Cup that will be competing in Sydney's ID10 are Power Of Tara, I Am Sam, Bondy, Ohoka Nevada, Notaswethort, Pembroke Benny, Smoken Up and Tanabi Bromac.

The \$400,000 BIG6 Hunter Cup is race eight at Moonee Valley's farewell meeting this Saturday night and is timed to run at 9:30pm.

Second Acceptances for the Watpac ID10 are due at Noon on Monday February 8th with Final Rankings for the Watpac Inter Dominion Championship released next Tuesday 9th February at 4.00pm.
