A FURIOUS AFFAIR

COMPETITION FOR POINTS DURING THE TWO ROUNDS OF HEATS FOR THE WATPAC INTER DOMINION SHOULD BE FURIOUS.

Commencing with the opening four heats at Harold Park tonight, those horses who will make their way through to the \$1million Grand Final will be the top 10 pointscorers throughout the series.

Points for the heats will be broken down as follows:

1ST	14
2ND	12
3RD	10
4TH	8
5TH	6

6TH	5
7TH	4
8TH	3
9TH	2
10TH	1

In the event of a dead-heat, the points for that particular finishing position will be divided equally.

Horses who fail to finish will receive no points.

With the first five horses across the line, and in particular the first three, gaining a significant advantage of those horses that finish out of the money, drivers are sure to be pushing their charges to the limit.

A handful of horses will enter tonight's heats with an added advantage of having accumulated bonus points prior to the series.

As the defending Inter champion, Mr Feelgood receives one point for this series, while he also receives a further half point after being tied with Blacks A Fake as Barastoc Grand Circuit Champion for 2009/10.

Any Grand Circuit winner from April last year up until February 8 this year, also receive a point for their victories.

Those horses that have already scored points so far are: Monkey King (3), Washakie (2), Mr Feelgood (1.5), Blacks A Fake (1.5), Cincinnati Kid (1), Bondy (1).
